

## MOSSEL BAY MUNICIPALITY

### DAYTONA RALLY 2020: 29 APRIL 2020: INNER CITY RACING: MOSSEL BAY

Notice is herewith given in terms of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, No. 32 of 2000 that during the Council Meeting held on 30 October 2019, Item E220-10/2019 it was resolved as follows:

- “1. *That approval be granted to Mr. G van Staden – Mossel Bay (the Applicant) to host the Daytona Rally 2020 on 29 April 2020 in Mossel Bay.*
2. *That a Daytona Event Committee consisting of members of the Applicant, Deputy Executive Mayor, Portfolio Chairperson of Community Services, Municipal Manager, Director: Community Services, Senior Manager: Support Services and officials nominated by the Municipal Manager be delegated to assist the Applicant and represent the Municipality.*
3. *That as this will be the first event of its kind in Mossel Bay, delegated powers be awarded to the Municipal Manager or his delegate to set all conditions and make all arrangements to make this event possible, including finalisation of the routes and setting of conditions.*
4. *That an Event Application be submitted to Directorate: Community Services for consideration and that all requirements be adhered to by the Applicant prior to approval.*
5. *That a Medical Risk Assessment be done and a Medical Plan be submitted to the satisfaction of the Committee.*
6. *That a Waste Management Plan be submitted to the satisfaction of the Committee.*
7. *That a Safety Risk Assessment be done by the Applicant and that a Safety Plan be submitted to, and approved by the Committee.*
8. *That a fire Safety Risk Assessment be done by the Applicant and be submitted to the Committee for approval.*
9. *That the Directorate: Community Services assists with traffic control, closing of streets and control on the streets during the event.*
10. *That the Neighbourhood Watch be approached by the Applicant to assist with safety and security of the spectators during the event.*
11. *That the Applicant be exempted in terms of the Western Cape Noise Control Regulations for hosting of the event from any provision of the Regulations subject to the following conditions:*
  - 11.1 *that a notice be placed to the satisfaction of the Municipal Manager or delegate in the local newspaper at the Applicants’ own cost.*
  - 11.2 *that the Municipal Manager or delegate may impose any noise restrictions during the event as he/she may deem fit.*

12. *That Public Liability Insurance be submitted to the satisfaction of the Directorate: Financial Services prior to the event.*
13. *That the Municipality be indemnified against any liability resulting from this event.*
14. *That the necessary marketing and media coverage of the event be done by the Applicant and that Mossel Bay Tourism be approached to assist in this regard.*
15. *That the necessary agreement be drawn up between the Municipality and the Applicant.*
16. *That a Public Participation Process be followed by the Applicant at their cost and that an Item be referred back to Council for consideration and that no rights shall vest prior to the signing of the agreement between the parties.*
17. *That a full report be submitted to Council after the event for consideration by Directorate: Community Services.”*

Any objections, comments or representations regarding the Municipality's intention should be lodged in writing to the Municipal Manager, P.O. Box 25, Mossel Bay, 6500, on or before Friday, 10 January 2020 at 12h00.
